INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON HOMELESSNESS

was established under the Office of the Governor

Continued funding to the AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST FUND with no diversions to address the state's 250,000 shortage of affordable home

\$80 MILLION

allocated to NJHMFA's Affordable Housing **Rehabilitation** and Renovation Program

\$30 MILLION

allocated to first generation homebuyers and the Resilient Home **Construction Pilot** Program

\$115 MILLION

allocated to the Affordable Housing Production Fund established last year through NJHMFA to help fulfill municipal housing obligations.
